MISSION/STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The Data Council ensures that the Eastside Pathways Partnership is using data strategically and across organizations to support the success of every child from cradle to career. We serve as a decision-making body and hands-on working group for the partnership on matters of data connection, access, and use.

GOALS

- Support data capacity and culture of data use in the collaboratives
- Establish principles/philosophies around data use for the partnership
- Keep and manage a priority list of questions that the partnership must address
- Facilitate action-oriented data sharing between partners (ex: <u>Tacoma</u>)
- Promote the disciplined use of data, including considerations of data quality
- Connect with other opportunities (state, local)
- Provide leadership on using data to tell the story of our community's needs

WORK IN PROGRESS

Launched and chartered in April 2017. Focus through January 2018 is making progress on one of the benchmarks in the StriveTogether Theory of Action that partners identified as a priority: "The partnership facilitates the collection and connection of academic data across the cradle to career pipeline and among partners to enable continuous improvement." Scoping questions will be selected in spring 2017.

DATA

The Data Council supports the Partnership by managing the selection, reporting, alignment, and use of our core, contributing, and context indicators.

WORKING AGREEMENTS

Be open to new ideas, thinking outside the box

Clear expectations for work outside of meetings

Commit the time (regular attendance, follow-up)

Assume best intentions

Agenda/documents one week in advance (thinking time)

Meetings purposeful and work-based

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Partner Leads: Meet monthly with the facilitator to plan agenda. Be content experts in the work. Lead discussions at meetings.

Facilitator: Participates in leading meetings, takes notes (or assigns to another collaborative member), sends out meeting notices, agenda, and notes. Plans agenda with Partner Leads.

DECISION MAKING

Decisions will be made by consensus using options (or types of "votes") at the point of decision-making:

- **Support** the proposal Agree this is the right thing to do and willing to implement/participate in next steps.
- **Accept** the proposal Unsure or disagree this is the right thing to do, but will not stand in the way of adoption, and willing to implement/participate in next steps.
- **Disagree** with the proposal Disagree this is the right thing to do and unable or unwilling to implement/participate in next steps.
- **Refuse** the proposal Such a high level of disagreement that adoption of the proposal puts the ongoing participation in the Collaborative and/or Eastside Pathways Partnership at risk.
