## MISSION/STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Keeping student and family needs at the center, we will seek to understand and improve our out of school time opportunities to get all students to grade level standard.

## **AGE FOCUS**

Students in grades K-5, although we recognize that some Partners serve additional grades up to grade 7.

#### **WORK IN PROGRESS**

Concluding campaign to create a one page document for FCC's and other connectors who are helping families connect to summer programming. These families may have attended summer school in the past, but are no longer eligible or need help in navigating summer opportunities. Our next step is to begin diagnosing for a new campaign.

### **SCOPING QUESTIONS**

- How do EP Partners work together to create summer and out of school time programming that meets the needs of families?
- How do we help families (and their supporters) identify, sign up for and attend summer and out
  of school time programming that meets their needs? (Can the current system be improved,
  especially for families who are at-risk whether that be low-income, kids not meeting academic
  standards or have high need for summer learning)

Outcomes related to scoping questions

#### **DATA**

Spring (End of Year) to Fall (Beginning for Year) Reading and Math Scores. Baseline of all kids, disaggregated by demographics, school, summer school attendee, BSD Paid or other Community Based organization program attendee.
