Learning Opportunties to Strengthen Capacities

Ensuring a common language and shared goals is key to accomplishing the work of changing and shaping systems. To aid in this process the Eastside Pathways Backbone is organizing learning opportunities to strengthen capacities around four key areas — Collective Impact, Adaptive Leadership, Equitable Results Series, and Racial Equity. These coaching sessions lay the foundation for impactful participation:

Eastside Pathways 101

An overview of the Eastside Pathways Partnership. Including how we work, the models, methods used, how we are organized, and how we measure success.

Partner representatives must attend EP 101 prior to participating in a Collabortive Action Network (CAN).

Eastside Pathways Institute

A focused one-day training on the core skills and capacities used in the Collective Impact model. Geared for Partners, both affiliated and non-affiliated, responsible for shaping systems for every child, step by step, from cradle to career.
